The first session of the final was won by the local pair of Valérie Carcassonne and Guy Polet, pulling them up to fifth place overall behind Myriam Varenne and Franck Multon of France who continue to lead. These will be looking over their shoulders at the rapid rise of Catherine D'Ovidio and Paul Chemla who have risen to 9th from position 175 at the start of yesterday.

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Prize Giving Ceremony

The Prize Giving Ceremony of the 7th European Bridge Mixed Pairs Championship will be held today in the playing room immediately after the publication of the results. A cocktail will follow, in the same room, in the area near the steps.



FIGHTING TO SURVIVE

One of the pre-tournament favorites pairs was Catherine D'Ovidio and Paul Chemla but a score just under 49% in the first session put them under some pressure as it was obvious they would need a good 52% to qualify among the first 130 pairs. Coming into the last eight boards we managed to watch what proved to be eventually the French pair's recovery. Their faces though were rather dull.

I WISH I DIDN'T HAVE TO LEAD

This was probably what Catherine thought when holding:

against her old friend and rival from Germany Pony Nehmert who is playing with Michael Yuen. As declarer he had opened INT (15/17), Two Hearts from the dummy (transfer), Two Spades, Three Diamonds, Four Spades from the opener.

Catherine led the ace of hearts, followed by the queen, and in no time East claimed her contract after successfully negotiating the trump position. Did you lead a diamond? Well done, but I just do not believe it! Anyhow, you get a score of 8% on the board.

DIFFICULT BID

This time, Paul was in a difficult position on board 21 against Mierzejewska (Mier to her friends) Aleksandra and Marek Witak from Poland. He was red against green and held:

He opened One Diamond, his partner responded One Spade, Two Hearts on his right, he raised to Two Spades, Three Hearts on his left, Four Hearts, a cue bid from his partner, Five Hearts on his right.

Your choice?

He passed with not too much of a problem, and his partner bid Five Spades. Do you raise or not? Partner has shown more than Four Spades but your trumps are not that good. Well, he

passed. Would you or wouldn't you?

West opened One No trump, North overcalled Two Hearts, transfer, East surprisingly passed and reopened with Three Clubs after South's bid of Two Spades. That was the final contract. Played from the wrong side of the table the contract could be held to nine tricks. The defence went wrong and allowed the declarer to take 11 tricks but still got 57% on the board as 3NT is cold as the cards lie and Five Clubs is difficult to beat with West as the declarer. May we suggest Rubensohl in this situation. East bids Two No trumps over Two Hearts as a transfer for Clubs.

Four Hearts was played by South because West doubled South's Two Diamonds transfer. West led the king of diamonds and South took the obvious eleven tricks, not risking the club finesse. It can be noticed that played by North on a spade lead the result is the same.

Even without any club finesse as West is squeezed in minors. So it happens that opening leads have no consequence after all.

The French pair scored 53% and had still some work to do to climb from their 175th position in the ranking after two qualifying... or eliminating sessions.

With 38 pairs in the field, France has an excellent chance of maintaining its record of always having a pair on the podium.

North opens 1NT, East overcalls Three Spades, South doubles and North bids 3NT. East does not give up to easily, so she re-bids her suit and what next? South can pass now, having shown all of her values before, so it's up to North. Double seems automatic, but 4NT might be an interesting alternative. If East leads a spade, declarer will probably come to ten tricks if he leads the ♣K from hand at trick two. Hearts and diamonds are out as possible leads, but the ♣10 lead will liven up the play. It looks, however, as if there still is a route to ten tricks for 630, a much better score than the 300 available in 4♠ doubled.

After making sure that 3♠ was a semi-natural bid only (it looked that way as East did not double 2♦) North, Michael Rosenberg, found the very inspired save in 4♠. The defence should manoeuvre to let East ruff a club in front of declarer's spade holding, but when this was not found, Michael only went one off. With so many vulnerable games on the scoresheet the number of undertricks did not really matter, however.

A fine slam was in the cards on this one, but how to bid it?

Old-fashioned methods work well here. North opened 1♦ and South responded 2♠. No matter what West does, the road to slam is wide open. North can show his support and cuebid hearts later on. Few pairs managed to reach it, however.

The Last Qualifying Session

With no less than 130 berths for the final at stake, many of the top-ranked pairs would not have to bother about their qualification, the only thing of interest (as usual) being their overall percentage i.e. their carryover score. Once again, in this report we will look at a few boards rather than at what would be too few out of so many good pairs present here.

EW clearly had won the auction by first finding the save against the cold 5♣ and then inducing their opponents to step overboard. The play's the thing however: there are two aces for the taking, but how can you know? East led an obvious ♠A on which West contributed the queen at lightning speed. Is this a singleton or a request to lead the highest-ranking other suit? The way you answer this question is the difference between a top and a zero.

3NT by South will be held to nine tricks on the natural lead

of the ♠J. When North is declarer, a minor suit lead will restrict declarer to the same nine tricks, but on a spade lead into the tenace the defence will have to create an illusion if they are to prevent the overtrick. The ♠Q wins and after crossing in diamonds declarer takes the heart finesse to East, who continues a spade. Declarer has to duck this, wins the next round and takes a club finesse which holds(!). Next come the hearts, on which both West and declarer throw a club. Now it looks safe enough to cash all the diamonds (the suit might be 3-3) and repeat the club finesse for eleven tricks, but if you do so, you end up with a meagre nine only. Well done, any West who made declarer fall into this trap.

Next, we have four boards about typical partscore decisions.

South has a promising hand, more than enough to overcall in spades after East opens 1♦. North will raise, but from there, everyone enters the Down Zone. It must be disappointing to find yourself in 3♣ which has no chance, saving against the opponents' minor suit partscore which would have suffered the same fate. The three small diamonds should have been your warning sign.

What should South do on this nice one?

East opens 1♥ and South bids 2♣. North raises to three and now it's South's turn again. Pass is obviously best, but 3NT looks

attractive. With diamonds 4-4, a working club finesse is the only thing needed. West can see this idea will fail, so his best action is to pass and collect a hundred points. If he doubles, South will probably run, and it needs careful defence to beat even Five Clubs.

On a heart lead, a diamond goes on the spades and a low club goes to the jack and king. Now a trump return is best, to prevent at least one heart ruff. Still, declarer can win in dummy and ruff out the ♠Q. Now, declarer ruffs the diamond return and gives up a heart. West has to throw his spades whenever given the chance on the hearts to come to another trick; if he does not, the ♠J can be cashed for declarer's 11th trick. A complete cross-ruff will not work as declarer will be short of trumps in his hand before she can cash the ♥A.

When North opens One Club and South responds One Heart, West might find the killing diamond lead against 4♥ by means of elimination. When South opens an 11-13 notrump and becomes declarer in 4♥ after a Stayman enquiry, the elimination process might get fatally disturbed and the contract might make.

What is an opening bid?

However, South missed the alert and assumed One Club was natural as would then be the case with INT. South's suspicions might have been aroused when North retreated to diamonds, but she took the bid at face value when she raised to game at her next turn. Despite the fact that North declined to double Six Hearts, South used a red card - and the contract had to go one down.

Hervé Pacault, imperturbable, passe et c'est alors que Colette Riberol, très inquiète, subit le stress dû à son enchère, surtout lorsque son partenaire s'est contenté de déposer le carton vert.

Est reste de marbre et Ouest entame du 5 de ♥.

Le temps de remercier intérieurement ce Roi bien placé (1ère bonne nouvelle), la déclarante le pose et joue le Roi de ♦. Elle revient du 2 de ♦ pour le Valet qui tient et s'empare de la Dame de Carreau au tour suivant.

Après avoir réalisé ses deux derniers ♦ (sur lesquels Ouest, sans doute désespéré, défausse le Roi de ♣ - 3ème bonne nouvelle - et un petit ♥), le reste n'est plus qu'un jeu d'enfant et la déclarante se retrouve à la tête de douze levées, accordant généreusement l'As de ♠ à ses adversaires un peu couards.

Loin de nous l'idée de polémiquer sur ce qui se serait passé sur une entame à ♠ (mais pourquoi entamer ♠ quand on possède les ♥), le contrat le plus sûr étant, bien entendu, 5♣. Quant à Est/Ouest, 5♥ (même contré en Est/Ouest), s'avère un bon résultat contre 5♣ réussi.

Cette donne a donné des résultats divers: Paul Chemla a joué 5♣ contré, d'autres ont joué 5♣ contré ou pas ou, ignorant une impasse, ont chuté de un.

Daniel Gelibter a joué 5♥ non contré contre Frank Multon et Philippe Cronier a également chuté de deux 5♥ non contré.

Valérie Carcassonne et Guy Polet n'ont pas annoncé 5♣, victimes d'une mauvaise explication. Est qui a annoncé les ♣ a fourni la bonne explication : Splinter. Valérie, restée dans un certain flou artistique (Splinter ou des valeurs dans la couleur, tels sont les renseignements donnés par Ouest), n'a pas continué le débat. L'arbitre, appelé à la table, l'a lui terminé, en accordant le bénéfice de la donne aux adversaires de nos compatriotes.

Following the Law

Writing bridge books is no way to make a living, but every once in a while a book catches the imagination of the public and gives both author and publisher a pleasant surprise. The top two books in the all time list are *Why You Lose at Bridge* and *Reese on Play*, the latter on sale in a new edition at the bookstall here in Ostend, while in recent years Larry Cohen's *The Law of Total Tricks* recorded unprecedented sales.

The basic idea is simple, you bid to the level of your trump fit. Look at this deal from yesterday's final qualifying session:

Despite having a flat hand, four card support for hearts means a jump to Three Hearts is in order. No problem for the bronze medal winner of 1998 one José Damiani, although one doubts he has had the time to read any bridge books in the last few years!

The subsequent bidding saw East/West emerge with an excellent score, as the position in diamonds meant there was no defence to Four Hearts.

The bidding strongly suggested that West lead a club and Damiani selected the ace. His partner encouraged with the four, so he continued with the jack. That held, so he played a third round, forcing dummy to ruff, which might have been awkward for declarer on a different layout. Here she could cash the queen of spades, come to hand with a diamond to the jack and play on spades, claiming ten tricks when West discarded on the third round.

Contract: Three Spades doubled, played by South.

Result: 9 tricks, N/S +730.

The Facts: North doubled and explained his double as either both Majors, or one Major and one Minor. This is in fact their system over a strong No trump. East bid 2♥ and alerted. Now North realized that East/West were playing weak No trump, and over this system the Double showed 13 points or more. North explained this to East, but at this point the stories differ. According to North, this explanation was given while the tray was still at their side, whereas East maintains the tray had already passed through. Anyway, North now calls the Director, asking if the weak NT has to be alerted. It hasn't. This first Director could contribute that, at the time he was at the table, the tray was already at the other side.

The bidding continues, and at the end, West calls the Director to complain about the wrong explanation he has received. Another Director arrives, who investigates and realizes that South has given the correct explanation (13+, according to the system) about the Double. Since West has received correct information, the attention then shifts to North/East. On that side of the screen there has been misinformation, if only for a short while. North had initially explained his double according to his hand, later correcting it to the correct systemic explanation.

The second Director learns about the first Director call and finds out that East had never indicated that she might have had a problem with the explanations.

The Director: Ruled that Players are expected to call the Director at the first sight of trouble. Not doing so can cause a loss of rights. If

East had asked to change her call, she could have been allowed to do so (provided her partner had not yet called). Since this possibility had now disappeared, there was no reason to change the result now.

Ruling: Result Stands

Relevant Laws: Law 9B, 11A, 21B

East/West appealed.

Present: All players.

The Players: North did not insist, during the hearing, that the tray was still on his side while he explained to East about his mistake.

West explained his penalty Double. He believed his partner, who had bid constructively over a penalty double. They had more points than opponents, so a penalty double was right.

If the Double had been explained correctly however, East could have passed, showing a willingness to play INTX. South would also have passed, and West would have played that contract.

West further explained that his partner never calls the Director, relying on her husband to do so. She did not ask to change her bid, believing that she could not, once the tray had passed to the other side.

The Committee: Read Laws 9 and 11 (extracts:)

Law 9B. After Attention Is Called to an Irregularity

1. *Summoning the Director*

(a) *When to Summon*

The Director must be summoned at once when attention is drawn to an irregularity.

(...)

2. *Further Bids or Plays*

No player shall take any action until the Director has explained all matters in regard to rectification and to the assessment of a penalty.

Law 11A. Action by Non-Offending Side

The right to penalise an irregularity may be forfeited if either member of the non-offending side takes any action before summoning the Director. (...)

By not asking the Director, who was after all at the table, if she could have changed her bid after the correction of explanation by North, East had in fact forfeited the rights she might have had. Law 21 says:

Law 21B. Call Based on Misinformation from an Opponent

1. *Change of Call*

Until the end of the auction period (see Law 17E), a player may, without penalty, change a call when it is probable that he made the call as a result of misinformation given to him by an opponent (...), provided that his partner has not subsequently called.

The (first) Director never had a chance to establish whether or not West had already called at the moment he was there, and so the (second) Director took a correct view when deciding that East had forfeited the rights she might have had.

The Committee's decision: Director's ruling upheld.

Deposit: Returned

Note by the Chairman: Law 9B is in the imperative. After an irregularity the Director must be called. If he is not it is likely that the non-offending side will lose its right to redress. If in this case East had called the Director at the appropriate time (when North changed his explanation), East/West would undoubtedly have received a ruling in their favour. As it was they got no protection and a bottom. Learn from their mistake and call the Director.
