## Tianjin-China October 21— 27, 2006 Bulletin No.1

## 1. Competiton Venue

Yifu Building at Tianjin Normal University (TNU).

Temperature during October 21—27 is between  $15\square$  and  $20\square$ .

Tianjin is one of the 4 municipalities in China with a history of more than 600 years. It covers an area of 11,305 km2 while with a population of 10,110,000.

#### 6. Financial Conditions and Insurance

- 1) According to the FISU regulations, each competing country should pay the following fees:
- \* Upon arrival: a. US\$20 per person, Registration Fee for the Member Associations (CIC)
  - b.US\$40 per person, Registration Fee for the Non-member Associations (CIC)
  - c. US\$60 per person and per day for participation fee (OC)

#### 9. Visa

The Chinese authorities recognize the importance of this championship and will cooperate very closely with the organizing committee. Each delegation must contact the Chinese Embassy or Consulate in its respective country as soon as possible in order to get detailed information and necessary visas. Competitors and other delegation members should therefore apply to Chinese Organizing Committee for entry visa if any difficulty occurs.

### 10. Transportation

The Organizing Committee will provide local transportation from Beijing International Airport and Tianjin International Airport to TNU-GBIH.

#### 11. Medical Services

1) Medical service will be provided by the Organizing Committee.

We ensure that the TNU Hospital will be available for all delegation members. The first aid service will be provided at the competition venue. The directory of nearest hospitals and emergency plan to this championship are also available.

### 12. Security

Municipal Public Security Bureau and TNU Security Office will safeguard the security of the participants at the competition and accommodation sites.

## 13. Conditions of participation with all entry forms

The individual dossier for each competitor to be presented to CIC must be written in English, and stamped with a seal from the concerning National University Sports Federation.

The following information must be included:

- \*A passport, including:
  - 1) Full name
  - 2) Nationality
  - 3) Date and place of birth
  - 4) A recent photo

#### \*If a student

- 1) A document providing that he/she has satisfied the conditions normally required in his/her country for entrance to a university or similar institute.
- 2) A student card or certificate originating from the appropriate academic authority certifying that the competitor is officially registered for and pursuing a full-time courses of study.
- 3) Certificate of eligibility

<sup>\*</sup>If a former student

Proof of the data he obtained his final academic degree or diploma.

#### \*If a pupil

A certificate of study signed, by hand, by the responsible official of the establishment certifying the date of entry into that establishment and that competitor has been regularly attending that establishment for at least two years.

- \*\*\* Only the competitors who satisfy the following conditions may take part to a FISU sporting event;
- --To be citizen of the FISU member they represent.
- --To be at least 17 and less than 28 years of age on January 1st in the years of event. ( to be born between January 1, 1978 and December 31, 1988)
- -- To meet the requirements laid down FISU regulations Art. 5.2
