Note 3 Rebid of 1NT after 1D opening

After 1D opening and 1M response 1NT shows 3 cards raise when 1D opening is sure unbal 1st/2nd position NV or 4th
In the other position 1NT is natural 12-14 bal.

NOTE 4 2C Response over 1M opening

The response of 2C is asking for strenght and distribution if opener shows a max hand it becomes F.G.

Normally we bid 2C with these type of hands:

5+C 11+ hcp

Balanced hand W or w/o fit 12+hcp

limit 3 card raise in partner's suit

strog hand with fit in this case we can have longer D or H not very good suit.
