World Transnational Mixed Teams

You can play in a world championship this fall without having to qualify in a team trials. Just sign up for the World Transnational Mixed Teams Championship, part of the World Mind Sports Games in Beijing, China, starting Oct. 3.

The mixed teams likely will start Oct. 12. The format will depend on the number of entries but probably will be Swiss teams qualifying to a knockout phase (round of 16 or eight) to determine the gold, silver and bronze medalists. The bronze medal will be awarded to the losing semifinalist placed higher in the Swiss rankings.

Teams must consist of two or three mixed pairs playing in partnership.

Teams can be made up of players from different countries, and there is no quota restriction for this exciting and challenging championship.

Players must be members in good standing of their national bridge organization (ACBL, for example) which must, in turn, be a paid-up member of the World Bridge Federation.

Teams should contact their NBOs and request nomination to play in the mixed teams.

NBOs may nominate as many teams as they wish.

Life Master news

Valerie Anderson of Las Vegas earned Life Master status. She needed 1.57 gold and picked that up playing in the Monday-Tuesday Knockout Teams with Jack Charles of Pittsburgh PA and Ava Itkis of Las Vegas.

The key question: At table 2, assuming everyone plays perfectly, would you prefer to be the declarer or a defender in 3NT?

At table 1, everybody was in the auction. If you think Palmer (West) was cautious, remember that East's 1♥ opening bid showed at most 15 high-card points because she had not opened 1♣.

2♠ stood no chance. South was given a chance to escape for down one, but in the end game played for spades to be 3-3 and went down two.

Now to 3NT by West. North has one lead and one lead only to defeat the contract: the ♠J. If declarer takes this trick and plays a heart, North wins with her ace and leads the ♠K, which South overtakes and cashes three more spades for down one.

If West ducks the ♠Q, North takes the ♠K, then shifts to a diamond. This sets up five tricks for the defense: three spades, one heart and one diamond.

Of course you would have led the ♠J!

The win was all the sweeter because the same team lost in the Spingold final in Nashville last year, falling to the powerful Nick Nickell squad.

The 2008 champions are Gromov and Aleksander Dubinin of Russia and Polish stars Cezary Balicki and Adam Zmudzinski.

The runners-up are Roy Welland, Brian Glubok, Garner, Howard Weinstein, Billy Cohen and Ron Smith.

It was the first Spingold win for Gromov and Dubinin but the third for their teammates, who were members of winning squads in 1997 and 2003. They were runners-up in 1998.

"It was a very strong field," said Gromov, who said playing four-handed did not affect the team's play.

Asked if he would have preferred to play Nickell in the final this year for a bit of revenge, Gromov said, "No. Nickell has too good a record in the Spingold."

The winners took the lead early but fell behind by the halfway point and were 8 IMPs in arrears with a quarter to go.

They started the fourth quarter with a vengeance, outscoring their opponents 16-0 over the first four boards.

Welland, known to prefer playing four-handed in long events, congratulated his opponents for their stamina.

When declarer played the ♥K, the bad split was revealed. She continued by leading a club to the 9 and East's 10. East exited with the ♦Q, won in dummy with the ace.

Declarer played the ♣A and when the king fell, she continued with a low club to her 8, finessing East's jack. She cashed the ♣Q and at this point had taken eight tricks. She exited with a diamond and East, who was down to all trumps, had to ruff his partner's winner. He was now endplayed and had to lead a heart into the ♥AJ to give Litwin her contract.

This was good for an 11 IMP pickup as her teammates played 4♠ for a score of minus 100.
